### <u>39<sup>th</sup> National YMCA Swimming and Diving Championship Meet</u> <u>April 21-23, 1966</u> <u>Hosted by the Kalamazoo, Michigan YMCA</u> <u>Held at the Western Michigan University Natatorium</u>

The 39<sup>th</sup> National YMCA Swimming and Diving Championship saw 208 young men representing 38 YMCA's from 15 states invade the city of Kalamazoo, Michigan and assembled on the beautiful campus of Western Michigan University for this year's meet. The Meet Director, Don McConnell, and his championship team were well prepared for the meet. A new event was added to the "Order of Events" which was the 800 Yard Freestyle Relay making a total of 18 events to be contested over the 3 days of competition. The defending championship team, Westfield, NJ and the Huntington, IN YMCA's were the two dominate teams in this year's Nationals by winning 13 of the 18 events. There were 7 new National Records established during the meet. Ross Wales from the Youngstown, OH YMCA and Steve Ware of the Huntington, IN YMCA set records in two events each. Wales in the 100 and 200 Yard Butterfly and Ware in the 200 Yard Individual Medley and the 200 Yard Breaststroke. Other National Records were set by Douglas McOwen of the Westfield, NJ YMCA in the 50 Yard Freestyle, Steve Folk Huntington, IN YMCA in the 400 Yard Individual Medley, and finally in the 800 Yard Freestyle Relay team of Dave Demarest, Tom McCoy, Craig Carins, and Bruce Hartlein from Weastfield, NJ.

Historical Biographical Sketch: Ross Wales, a competitor in this meet, started swimming at the Youngstown YMCA in 1956, and swam with the YMCA Neptune Swim Club until his graduation from high school in 1966. In 1965 Ross was the #1 ranked high school swimmer in the 100 yard butterfly in the Unites States. He represented his YMCA in our National Championships for 4 years and dominated the 100 yard butterfly event. He set new National Records in 1964, 65, and 66. Ross went on to attend Princeton University, where in 1967 he won the 100 yard butterfly event in the NCAA Championship. This was followed by a 2<sup>nd</sup> place finish behind Mark Spitz in the 1967 Pan American Games. In 1968 Ross became a member of the US Olympic team winning the Bronze Medal in the 100 meter butterfly. Upon graduation he entered the University of Virginia Law School prior to entering the U.S. Army. Presently Ross is a Partner in the Law Firm of Taft Stettinius & Hollister LLP in Cincinnati, Ohio. In the 1990's swimming became a Wales family affair when Ross's sons Dod, and Craig Wales became members of the M.E. Lyons YMCA Swim Team and participated in our YMCA National Swimming and Diving Championship Meets for several years, distinguishing themselves as outstanding swimmers as well. Dod, in 1999, his senior year at Stanford, was the American Record Holder in the 100 Yard Butterfly. I understand that he also won the NCAA Championship in that event and that Ross and Dod at that time were the first father and son combination to have won a NCAA Championship in the same event. Also I believe that Ross presented Dod's medal at that championship event.

**Special Note:** Back in 1964 Ross Wale's father Dr. Craig Wales served of on the Championship Committee of the 37<sup>th</sup> National YMCA Swimming and Diving Championship held in Youngstown, Ohio April 9-11<sup>th</sup>.
