Draft: 1923 Swimming & Diving Championship Tournament May 19, 1923 Hosted by the Brooklyn Central Branch YMCA

There were Nine Young Men's Christian Associations from Five States that took part in the First National Y.M.C.A. Swimming Championship that was held at the Brooklyn Central YMCA on May 19, 1923. Teams came from as far west as Cincinnati, Ohio (Central Parkway Branch), and as far north as Toronto Ontario, Canada (West End Branch). Also teams from Auburn, Maine; Worcester, Massachusetts; Summit, Passaic, and Bayonne, in New Jersey, and finally teams from New York; (Buffalo, West Side Branch and Brooklyn Central Branch) participated in the meet.

<u>Note:</u> In the historical material received there is no information regarding officials; a Championship Committee, a Meet Director or a Meet Referee, etc. Also there is no listing of an "Order of Events" or indication as to the number of participants.

Meet Highlights: The feature race of the evening was the neck and neck battle between Harry Lewis (Brooklyn Central) and Louis Rutledge (Cincinnati Central Parkway). Both men raced on even terms throughout the 100 yards, with Lewis winning out by a margin of inches at the finish. There were 5 National Records established during the meet as indicated above (*). This being the 1st National Championship it would stand to reason that each event would have established a new record. However the National YMCA Physical Education Department must have established a Competitive Swimming Records system prior to this event. (Will need to research this!)
