6th International/National YMCA Swimming & Diving Championships April 13-14, 1928 Hosted by the YMCA of Chicago

Editorial Note: Louis A. Cox, a participant in this meet, was a Joseph G. Rogers Award recipient in 1982. Lou Cox was born in Yokohama, Japan of an American Father and a Japanese Mother. He came to America in 1925 after being educated in Hawaii and landed in Dayton, Ohio. Lou entered the University of Dayton and graduated in 1930. Determined to follow a career in the Young Men's Christian Association, he took over the pool at the Dayton YMCA. His exceptional YMCA career of over 30 years took place mostly in Dayton, Ohio with short stays in Baltimore, Maryland, and Westfield, Massachusetts. While in Massachusetts, he took time to do advanced studies at the YMCA College in Springfield, Massachusetts. As the Physical Director in Dayton, Lou developed an outstanding reputation as Physical Educator and was a strong supporter of YMCA Competitive Aquatics. In the mid 1950's thru the early 1960's, Lou Cox was an avid supporter of our YMCA National Swimming and Diving Championships and kept it alive by promoting and hosting both the 1958 and the 1960 YMCA National Meets.
