The Queen was <u>Mary Freeman</u>, a 17 year-old from Washington D.C., who was favored to win a birth on the 1952 Women's USA Olympic Team. Mary at the time was the defending national champion in the 100 and 200 Meter Backstroke events. Mary did become a member of the 1952 Women's U.S. Olympic Team.
