-30th International/National Swimming & Diving Championships April 11-13, 1957

Host: Richmond, Indiana YMCA

Swimming: Held at the Richmond YMCA Pool

Diving: 1 Meter held at the YMCA
3 Meter held at Miami University Pool

The 30th International / National YMCA Swimming and Diving Championships were held in the newly constructed Richmond YMCA. One hundred and seventy competitors were entered, representing 24 YMCA's from 12 states and Canada. Despite the illness of the Physical Director, Jack Tanner, his hard work and delegated assignments proved to be most successful in the conduct of the meet.

Note: Although there are many very good reasons why an event of this stature should be held in a YMCA, all too often the facilities do not meet the requirements for an event of this magnitude. The pool as fine as it was, not only lacked a three meter diving board but only accommodates four swimmers for a six man final event. To solve these problems Jack Tanner, the Physical Director of the Richmond Y arranged for the 3 meter diving event to be held at Miami University (approximately 25 miles southeast) in Oxford, Ohio. Coach Raymond Ray the Swimming Coach at Miami University was Diving Referee. He, along with the athletic staff at the University, conducted both of the diving events, 1 meter at the Richmond Y and the 3 meter in Oxford, Ohio. Regarding 5th and 6th place they were awarded to the swimmers with the fifth and sixth fastest times in the preliminary heats. In the case of duplicate times for 4th place, there would be a swim-off conducted and the loser would be awarded 5th place.

Upon graduation he entered the Young Men's Christian Association movement and gave unselfishly of his time and talents to further the growth and development of all aspect of YMCA Aquatics. His career encompassed many positions during is 35+ years of service to the Young Men's Christian Association. Jack was a also a member the National YMCA Competitive Swimming and Diving Council for many years. In 1986 he was and was honored as the thirteenth recipient of the **Joseph G. Rogers Award** presented at the International Swimming Hall of Fame pool in Ft Lauderdale, Florida. He and his wife Jane became widely known as "**Mr. and Mrs. Charisma and Congeniality**" heading up the Sales Area for many years at the Short Course National Y Meets. Jack H. Tanner departed his earthly life in the early morning hours of March 10, 2007.

Biographical Note: William Mulliken, a participant in this meet from Champaign, IL, went on to Miami University in Oxford, Ohio and had an outstanding career in competitive swimming. Bill was inspired by a motivational talk given by Olympic Pole Vaulting Gold Medalist Bob Richards vowed that he was going to win a Gold Medal at the 1960 Olympics. Winning the Gold Medal in the 200 Meter Breaststroke in the 1959 Pan American Games he set the stage for his 1960 Olympic quest in Rome. By winning the 200 Meter Breaststroke Gold Medal in Rome, Mulliken not only surprised his Olympic Coach Gus Stager, but his other breaststroke competitors, and the entire Olympic community, as the USA had not won a Breaststroke Event in the Olympics since 1924. In 1984, William Danforth Mulliken was inducted into the International Hall of Fame. **Note:** Excerpts from the above material have been taken from his ISHOF Induction information and the internet.
